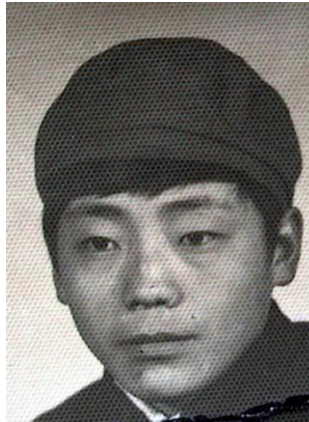




Mr. Bai Heguo Died Two Weeks after Being Transferred to Nanguanling Prison

Victim:

Mr. Bai Heguo, 45 years of age, lived in Xiguangshan Village, Liutiao Town in Dengta City, Liaoning Province.

On June 9, 2002, the police from the Tongerpu District Police Department arrested Mr. Bai Heguo for practicing Falun Gong. He was then sentenced to 11 years in prison and held in the Liaoning Province Huazi Prison. Although Mr. Bai endured various forms of torture over the past several years he remained firm in his faith.

At the end of December 2007, without notifying his family, the Huazi Prison Administration secretly transferred Mr. Bai to the Nanguanling Prison in Dalian City. On January 5, 2008, at 3:00 p.m., the prison administration notified Mr. Bai's family that he had died.

His family reports that his body was covered with bruises, and there was a bump on his head. He had clearly endured horrendous torture. The authorities hurriedly cremated the body. His family carried his ashes home on the morning of January 9, 2008.

Later it was disclosed that not only was there a bump on Mr. Bai's head, but there was also a cut on his tongue, which protruded outside his mouth. His leg was broken, his testes had been crushed, and he was emaciated. It appears that Mr. Bai Heguang had been beaten to death.

Nanguanling Prison agents fabricated "proof" that Mr. Bai had committed suicide. Mr. Bai Heguo had been jailed in Huazi Prison for several years. On December 19, 2007, he was transferred to Nanguanling Prison. Mr. Bai died just two weeks later, on January 5, 2008.



Ms. Gu Jianmin Died after Only Thirteen Days in Custody

Victim:

Ms. Gu Jianmin, 53, lived in the 13th Building-Apt. 601, 400 Lane, Yangguangxincun Neighborhood, Qishan Street, Pudong New District, Shanghai.

Ms. Gu Jianmin, a Falun Gong practitioner, was arrested on March 1, 2008, by officers from the Yangjing Police Station in Pudong New District, Shanghai. She died on March 13, 2008.

On March 13, 2008, an agent of the Pudong New District “610 Office” called Ms. Gu’s husband, saying that she was not well, and that he should come and process a medical parole. They told her husband to go to the Pudong New District Police Department, and the Neighborhood Administration, to do the medical parole paper work. This process dragged on from 12:30 p.m. until 3 p.m. Some unknown person had Ms. Gu’s husband sign an arrest warrant during this time period. Upon arriving at the hospital, Ms. Gu’s husband was forced again to sign an arrest warrant. When he later found Ms. Gu by himself, she was in the Gastric lavage room. He saw that her eyes were protruding, her pupils were enlarged, and she was bleeding from the mouth, but no one was taking care of her. Her husband knelt down in front of the doctors and begged them to save his wife. The doctor conducted a rather quick attempt to rescue her, and declared that she was dead.



There were more than thirty "610 Office" agents present, and some of them were plainclothes officers. The hospital's security guards were waiting in the hospital room, and took Ms. Gu's body to the morgue while some of the others surrounded her husband to restrain him. Ms. Gu's husband was very angry. He loudly declared that he would find out who the killers were. All of the agents quickly fled, and only some of the plainclothes police officers were hiding in the crowd. Ms. Gu's husband could not find any of the agents. The doctor told him that Ms. Gu was dying when she arrived at the hospital. The hospital issued a critical condition notice, which should be signed by the immediate family, but was signed instead by an unknown person. Ms. Gu's husband realized the "610 Office" and the detention center tricked him into agreeing to a medical parole in an attempt to avoid any responsibility for Ms. Gu's death.

Ms. Gu had been detained in a forced labor camp for one year in 2006 because she clarified the true facts about Falun Gong. This time within thirteen days of her arrest, Ms. Gu, a healthy woman, died in police custody. The Pudong District "610 Office" and the Pudong New District Detention Center are responsible for Ms. Gu's death.



Mr. Gu Qun Dies within 23 Days of Arrest in the Yaojia Detention Center in Dalian City, Liaoning Province

Victim:

Mr. Gu Qun, male, was born on March 11, 1958. He worked for the Xigang District Industrial and Commercial Bureau in Dalian City, Liaoning Province.

Description:

On the afternoon of March 16, 2008, officers from the Tianjin Street Police Station arrested Mr. Gu while he was distributing Falun Gong materials. The next day they took him to the Yaojia Detention Center. He went on a hunger strike to protest the persecution and was violently force-fed and tortured. On April 7, 2008, the detention center took him to the Dalian City Third People's Hospital. The doctor said that he must be admitted to the hospital as he needed urgent care, but the detention center staff said that he would be taken to the Police Hospital. However, he was taken back to the detention center instead. At 9 a.m. on April 8, 2008, the center administration took Mr. Gu Qun to the Third People's Hospital again; only it was too late because he had already died by the time he arrived there. The police waited until after 2 p.m. on April 9 to notify his family that he had died.



When word of Mr. Gu's death leaked out, all of his friends were saddened and shocked. Only 23 days had passed between the time of his arrest and his death as a result of torture.

Previous Persecution:

In February 2000, **Mr. Gu Qun** rode the train to Beijing to appeal for the right to practice Falun Gong. He was arrested, escorted back to Dalian, and then detained at a drug rehabilitation center. To protest the persecution, he went on a hunger strike. When he returned to work after his release, he was disciplined. During this period, He was pressured to give up his belief, and he was threatened with unemployment and a reduction in pay.

Near the end of the disciplinary period, Mr. Gu was still practicing Falun Gong, so his employer, 610 Office personnel, and other authorities colluded to have him sent to a brainwashing center. With no other options, he became homeless and went into hiding. . Six months later, he was arrested again in his hometown.

After his appeal in Beijing, Mr. Gu was arrested five times, detained, sentenced to forced labor, and severely persecuted. Here is one example.

The Chinese authorities wanted to make a "typical example" of Mr. Gu as a "[transformed](#)" Falun Gong practitioner. On November 22, 2001, at the Qingniwa Bridge Police Station in Dalian City, they set up the camera and focused on his face only. His hands and legs were shackled to a metal table. He could not move at all. Above his head was an air-conditioner and beside him a bucket of cold water, a ladle, and a towel. Several CCP officials from six departments, headed by the 610 Office, sat across from him. They ordered him to raise his head, but he did not move. They tried to force him to defame Falun Gong, but Mr. Gu did not say anything. They threatened him again, but he still did nothing. They repeated this several times with no success. Infuriated, the officials stripped off all of his clothes. With Mr. Gu completely naked, the officials put the wet towel on his body, opened the window, and turned the air-conditioner full force. They then poured the cold water down his neck.



Mr. Sun Guanzhou Dies after Only Seven Days in Custody in Henan Province



Victim:

Mr. Sun Guanzhou, male, 62, lived in Yuzhou City, Henan Province. He was a professor teaching at Yuzhou City Education College.

Description:

At around 9 a.m. on March 3, 2008, **Mr. Sun Guanzhou** was eating at home when Domestic Security agents Xia Yuxiao, Geng Sontao, Zhao Naicheng and three other agents ransacked his home and arrested him for practicing Falun Gong. They had no warrants. They took him to the city detention center that same night.

On the morning of March 6, 2008, the police notified his wife that they had taken him to Beiguan Hospital. The doctor said that he had asthma and high blood pressure, and his condition was not suitable for remaining in detention. His wife demanded that he be admitted to the hospital, but the secret agents would not allow it. His family then asked agent Geng Songtao to release him. Geng Songtao demanded 25,000 Yuan ransom. Mr. Sun's wife could only come up with five thousand Yuan, which Geng refused, saying it was not enough to get Mr. Sun released and that "I don't make the decision."

At around 8 p.m. on March 9, 2008, Mr. Sun's wife received a phone call to return to the hospital. When she arrived, she saw her husband's corpse. She was distraught! Agents tried to keep her from the body and tried to force her to sign papers to have his body cremated. She cried out, "I want him alive!" Then she fainted. All the agents quickly left, leaving her in the morgue.

On the afternoon of March 10, 2008, Mr. Sun's wife went to the hospital again to see his body, but the agents refused to allow her to see her dead husband. They again tried to force her to sign the cremation papers. Mr. Sun's wife tried to find a lawyer to help. All the lawyers know this is typical of the persecution against Falun Gong, so no one has dared to accept her as a client.



Ms. Zong Xiuxia Dies Suddenly While in Police Custody

Description:

On February 22, 2008, the police arrested **Ms. Zong Xiuxia** while she was shopping at the Jialejia Supermarket on Xinhua Street, Weifang City, Shandong Province.

It was 9:00 p.m. when the police notified her family. They said they found her checkbook in her handbag and thus found her name and address. The police said they took Ms. Zong to the Weifang City People's Hospital for a physical check-up at around 1:00 p.m. However, Ms. Zong died at 3:00 p.m. They said she died from jumping out of the elevator in the hospital.

Ms. Zong's family was very shocked about her death. They asked several question about it: What happened in the Guangwen Police Station before they took her to the hospital? Why did the police take her for a physical so soon after she was arrested? How could she jump out of the elevator in a crowded hospital in the middle of the afternoon? Why didn't they search her handbag, ascertain her identity and notify her family sooner? Why wouldn't they allow her family to meet with the three officers?

After only four hours, a perfectly healthy, upstanding person died while in police custody, and it took six hours for them to notify her family.
